President Report

- Spring Into Action over several mos. \$3K raised for variety of activities, seniors meals on wheels, kids against hunger, kindness rocks; helped family that lost their home to fires
- Player reached out to Cassandra about how to get involved in steering committee.
 Brought tears to her eyes. Cassandra wants to organize event to recognize players who have contributed the last few years.
- Thanks to Dan Allari and Mike Stewart for joining us in their last board meeting. Members offered their gratitude for the significant contributions of these board members over several years
- Cassandra mentioned several topics:
 - Advocating return to play
 - Financial support for Bernal fields
 - How we support retention of staff
 - Combat covid related attrition
 - How we manage frustration of competitive families
 - Dan suggested more regular touchpoints. He believes too much silence.

- Eric said he is supportive of our posture, but message was weeks ago and we need to amplify our message. We need to reinforce our messaging.
 Suggested we send updates at regular intervals.
- Cassandra wondered if message needs to be focused on covid only
- Erin: with every new cycle update we send out (every 3 weeks), we put update at bottom
 - Cassandra, suggested we separate it out
- Erin, no change to state protocols since Aug.
- Dan, people feeling especially isolated and disconnected without attending games, etc. Use school district as a model. They are out communicating us.
- Mike, our need is to quell rumor mill. Offering Covid hotline, tool,
- Corbett reinforced a good idea to keep the communication related to covid above the fold
- Martha in non-covid times, we had coach communication coming to parents. Is this an opportunity to have coaches communicate direct with their team?
- Cassandra coaches need to toot their own horn in communications about what they are doing for the team.
 - Erik highlighted Toby as being best in class
 - Dan: over communicated can be ignored, under communicate and our customers can feel ignored

- Financially strong
- o Revenues down, expenses also down
- Tax returns for 2019 also returned
 - 990s are the return
 - Generally we get extension to last mo.
- o PPP loan forgiveness application completed; working w/ bank before submitting
- \$10K loss in fundraising because we had some Orange & Gold expenses after fiscal year turned
- VP COMP

- NLI day is tomorrow, small event at Patelco tomorrow afternoon; 10 players committed
- Comp program survey pushed to when teams are training as full teams and hopefully competing; need by end of March to do evals
- Cassandra: why wouldn't we want to understand how things are going during
 Covid stage
 - Erin: two surveys may water down responses; teams split currently
 - Cassandra: can we do more simple 1-3 question check-in
 - Erin: we sent Covid survey out w/ virtual training and webinars (4-5 mos.
 ago)
 - Dan: 4-5 mos. ago is long time ago, surveys let customers know you care about them. Acknowledge in the survey, the scenario we are in.
 - Cassandra: surveys can be formative rather than summative
 - Corbett: starting out feelings were this is not going to be great. Turns out
 girls are having fun. In many cases they have advanced quickly. Perception
 of season now is completely different. Guess is that most customers are
 happy they signed up.
 - Cassandra: to Corbett's point, believes we will find positive linings and we
 need to broadcast those positive comments
 - Mike: we have historically published summaries of survey results. REC survey would be similar this year.
 - Erin clarified that survey we are talking about would not be coach specific then but higher level. It was suggested it be split by COMP and REC at minimum
- WPSL May through early July (college aged player league). They've extended due date to March and we have \$1K credit from prior season.
- Scholarship will get posted and sent out to Seniors in January

REC VP

- REC season coming to a close, games not possible this year
- A lot of positives to take away from season
- Halloween event and practices well received
- Send Collin ideas for REC survey
- Focus on bringing soccer to forefront of minds of players for 2021 for those who did not participate this year

- o Important to think about ideas for volunteer coach retention
 - We need to get appreciation messages out
 - He's concerned that some may have off year (especially without playing games)
- Cassandra suggested card design and card sent to coaches
- o Dan: gave history on gifts and walk around hand shakes to thanks coaches
- Mike asked who is organizing gifts this year. Colin said he would check in w/
 Tamie and Megan, he was not doing it. Randy stated Karie Smith has ordered gifts in recent years.
- o Erin says she has a lot of left over Adidas gear.
- Randy, need outreach to coaches who didn't coach because it will be easier for them to continue in non coach mode next year
- Erik communication of positive stories is key

- DOC

- Shout out to board for support with these challenging times
- Frustrating we don't have state updates, but NorCal feeling more confident we will have updates by end of next week
- Hearing that something will be in guidelines to discourage out of state play
- Utah just shut down sports yesterday for remainder of month
- Nevada facilities are shutting down
- We plan to wait until new recommendations come out before we plan any out of state play
- Only if new guidelines show play is not imminent, then maybe an indoor space in Reno is an option (only weekday availability though)
- PSRA having personnel changes and long term stability at-risk. We are looking to create association with other clubs.
 - High admin expenses
 - Bidding wars w/ refs w/ other local clubs
 - Rating systems and standardization to improve quality
- Most likely new referee association would come into effect in fall 2021
- Real concern with referee shortage due to attrition and high school overlapping
 - US Soccer making requirements more burdensome
- o Highlighted that back end of seasons may need to run through June and July
- Event tomorrow will be great way to recognize our 10 girls signing tomorrow
- Comp uniforms have not arrived yet. We will not need to use funds approved to front money.
